

LOKAHI DANCE 2023-2024 POLICIES & CLASS INFORMATION

TUITION

Season Classes (School Term)

2023-2024 Season Classes run September 18 - May 31

Tuition for the Season can be paid in full or will be divided into equal monthly installments. Your first tuition installment plus a family registration fee is due upon enrollment.

Family Registration Fee: \$30

(45min) class per week: \$65 monthly installments or \$520 paid in full (60min) class per week: \$75 monthly installments or \$600 paid in full

- Lokahi Dance requires you to keep an updated credit or debit card in your online member portal for monthly tuition installments. Billing is set up to withdraw automatic tuition payments from the card associated with your account on the <u>1st day of each month</u> November - May.
- If a payment is declined, you will receive an email to update your payment info. We will attempt to process payment again each following day if there is a remaining balance due.
- A late fee of \$15 will apply to any unpaid balances on the 7th of the month. Please keep your account information updated to avoid late fees!
- Tuition and fees are non-refundable.

Recreational Classes (Short Sessions)

- Please see the recreational class schedule for pricing and dates
- Tuition for Recreational Classes must be paid in full for the session and is due upon enrollment
- Recreational Classes do not participate in Recital but will have a final day showcase.
- Tuition is non-refundable, no exceptions.

- 10% Sibling or Multi-Class Discount automatically applies to additional classes. Siblings must be on the same account for the discount to apply.

Season Classes (School Term)

Winter Showcase Week: <u>December 18 - 22</u> at Lokahi Dance Studio

• All School Term students perform in an informal class showcase the week prior to Winter Break. Families are invited to come watch what their dancers have been practicing this Semester! Classes will start at their usual times.

Picture Day: Saturday, April 20th at Lōkahi Dance Studio (Times TBA)

• School Term students will wear their costumes for Picture Day! Professional photos will be provided by Tot Shots. Photos will be uploaded into an online gallery for parents to order post Picture Day. Ask for pricing details.

Recital: Saturday, June 1 at The Kroc Center Theater (Time TBA)

- Recital fee is due on November 1, 2023
- Recital fee: \$100 for 1 student in 1 class.
- 10% Discount applies for each additional class or student in a family.
- Recital fee includes: 1 hand steamed recital ready costume, digital show recording, digital program, and an award for completing the season.
- Tickets will be available for purchase in the Spring and range from \$10-20 per person.
- Recital Fees are <u>non-refundable</u>

CLOSURES / MISSED CLASS / CANCELLATION

- The studio will be closed on the holidays listed above.
- We reserve the right to cancel class due to inclement weather or mandatory evacuations. If classes are canceled, you will be notified by email. No refunds or credits will be issued.
- In the event mandatory statewide or county closures occur, Lokahi Dance may transition in person classes to virtual classes and tuition will be due as usual. No refunds or credits will be issued.
- We reserve the right to cancel class due to low enrollment. A minimum of 5 students are required to hold a class.
- In the event a teacher is sick, a substitute teacher will be provided OR a make-up class will be scheduled.
- In the event a student is sick, a make-up class can be taken in any class of the same age/level within the same month of missed class. <u>Please contact us to schedule your make-up class.</u>

- Tuition is non-refundable. No refunds or credits will be issued for missed classes.
- We require a 2-week written withdrawal notice to cancel your enrollment. Please email us (<u>info@lokahidance.com</u>) 2-weeks prior to the next billing cycle to avoid tuition charges.
- If we are unable to process your tuition and there is no contact for 15 days, your enrollment will be dropped.

CLASS INFORMATION & ETIQUETTE

- We require all dancers to be fully potty trained at time of enrollment.
- Please have your dancer use the restroom before class.
- Please have your dancer arrive wearing proper dance attire.
- Please arrive <u>5 minutes</u> prior to class time. Parents are responsible for their children before and after class time.
- Students must remain in the lobby or student lounge until the instructor begins class.
- We prefer students to be dropped off to eliminate classroom distractions.
- A parent may stay in the lobby as long as they observe *quietly*.
- Please refrain from bringing guests/family members in regularly to watch class. We will have a showcase week in December where students can invite family members to observe!
- Students who arrive late to class are asked to wait at the entrance of the dance floor until the teacher signals it is safe to enter class.
- We require students to demonstrate respectful and appropriate behavior in class
- Running or horseplay is not permitted.
- Keep your child home if they have a fever or show signs of illness.
- Please no food or chewing gum in the studio.
- We encourage students to bring a reusable water bottle to class!

DRESS CODE

- Only dance shoes are allowed on the studio floor. Refrain from wearing dance shoes outside of the studio.
- Please remove hanging jewelry before entering the studio floor.
- Hair must be styled back away from face.

Acro - Bare Feet, Leotard, Stretch Shorts or Leggings

Ballet - Girls: Pink Ballet Slippers, Tights, Leotard with Tutu attached (any color)

Boys: Black Ballet Slippers, Black Shorts, White T-Shirt

Discover Dance - Girls: Bare Feet, Footless Tights and Leotard. Boys: Bare Feet, Black Shorts and White T-Shirt.

Breakdance - Clean Dance Sneakers and Comfortable Workout Clothing

Jazz & Hip Hop - Black Dance Sneakers and Comfortable Stretch Clothing

Hula - Stretch Shorts or Leggings, Hula Skirt (Pa'u)*, Tank or T-Shirt. *Pau
